Page one

A little drier forecast in South America, combined with Commodity Fund buying and Index Fund Buying has caused a rally in the grains for the week. Many prices hit my FC/CC numbers and then eased off, especially Wheat. My Cash Grain Indicator (CGI) is giving me a weak sell signal in New Crop Wheat (My Sale Recommendation was fill on Friday) and is giving me a strong sell signal for New Crop Corn. My research has indicated a drought for 2006, but because of weather changes about 22 days ago, it now looks a little less severe, like a moderate drought. I'll be able to update more in five weeks.

Looking at seasonals, CGI, price action, current fundamentals, combined with farmers needing money for costly inputs, I recommend selling 10% more Old Crop Corn, bringing you up to 60% sold. Sell your first 10% for New Crop, picking a delivery time at harvest or what works best for you. Your choice of Hedge to Arrive or Cash Forward Contract. Do all of this on Monday's opening. Next week, I will publish some of my price projections, sell recommendations levels and excerpts from my January research when I get back to the office for the week.
