Today saw the funds buying on the open and then turned sellers when the market failed to move higher after rally attempts. Get used to this volatility. It's only going to get worse. By mid-morning I was going to recommend adding to sales, but when the markets closed lower as they did, I have decided to make adjustments in the sales recommendations and wait for a better day. Although the prices have been artificially bolstered to these price levels by funds, it is still early in the year. Sales for New Crop Corn and Beans should be done using Hedge to Arrive contracts with your local elevator, if possible because the basis is abnormally wide due to the inflated prices created by funds rather than by commercial interest. If filled, I will establish the cash part of the contract hopefully at a narrower basis later in the year.

Prices might take a breather for a while (typical "February break") before another rally attempt. I still predict higher prices during the seasonal high periods in Spring/early Summer than what we have presently, but we need to be ready to trigger sales quickly.

I have adjusted quantity and price levels for my recommendations, so read them carefully and make the adjustments at your elevator. Get the orders in ahead, because they can hit and then move lower in price very quickly.
