Surprise! Grain markets were sharply higher today as a result of technical buying- mostly program trading, buy stops, and a little fund activity. With about 50% of the volume going electronic trading direct from one's desk trading computer into the exchange computer, it is getting harder to find out who is doing the buying.

Corn. This is the time for a catch up sale. Officially, I am at 50% sold. Please re-estimate your yields and make additional sales, if necessary, to bring you up to that 50% level. If you are at 50%, please be patient. I am in no hurry to add additional sales at this time.

Soybeans. As instructed by phone an hour earlier: With Soybeans closing nearly 13 cents higher today, please take your LDPs on those harvested bushels that have been sold. For those Soybeans sold and not harvested, take an LDP if possible when you harvest. For those Soybeans that will be stored, wait to take the LDP until I broadcast to do so. With good yields, I still feel there will be more harvest pressure and the LDPs are a safety net right now.

Wheat: Here is a second chance, if you haven't done so already to price 30% of intended production for July, 2007.

CURRENT CROP 2006 WHEAT: We have finished sales

CURRENT CROP 2006 SOYBEANS: We have sold 40%. No additional recommendations.

CURRENT CROP 2006 CORN: We have sold 50%. Catch up if necessary.

NEW CROP 2007 WHEAT: We have sold 30%. No additional recommendations.

NEW CROP 2007 SOYBEANS: No additional recommendations.

NEW CROP 2007 CORN: We have sold 10%. No additional recommendations.
